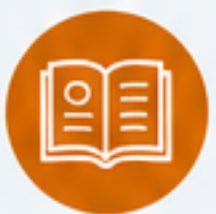
Beyond Silos

FOOD INSECURITY TEAM

Developed a Collaboration Field Guide to help organizations strengthen partnerships, reduce duplication, and increase collective impact.
